How should the officials rule on this play, according to NFHS rules?

- A is lined up in a scrimmage kick formation, to attempt a punt. The long snap hits the ground, and is picked up by the kicker. The kicker side steps a player from team B, takes a step and kicks the ball cleanly. Two defenders then make hard contact with the kicker, taking him off of his feet. How do we rule?
- A. Clean play, no foul
- B. Roughing the kicker 15 yards and automatic first down
- C. Running into the kicker 5 yards and replay the down

Answer: B

- The ball is about to become live. A coach is in the restricted area. The line judge blows his whistle to stop all action. What is the appropriate action by the officials in this instance?
