

RCCFO 2022 Youth League

RCCFO Expectations

All youth games will be assigned 3 officials – if covered then a 4th official will be assigned to Monroe County games.

Officials will acknowledge within 24 hours of game assignment, or they will be removed. Two occurrences will result in removal from future youth game assignments.

RCCFO Responsibilities: Youth League

- **RCCFO Officials – Head Referee Responsibilities**
 - Notification to crew no later than Tuesday (email or phone call)
 - Notification to include the following:
 - Arrival time (at least 30 minutes prior to first game)
 - If traveling together – identify a time & meeting place
 - Uniform for the day
 - How many games scheduled
 - Notify assignors (Varsity, Sub Varsity, & Youth) that your crew is set
 - No notification to assignors can jeopardize additional youth assignments
 - Properly document & report any game issues
 - Ejection(s), coach, player (get names)
 - Behavior of coaches / fans
 - Payment issues
 - Availability of site representative
 - Official issues
 - RCCFO to establish what documents are needed and to make available to membership on web site
 - Need to notify assignors and RCCFO president of any problems by Sunday evening
 - This allows for ample time to follow-up with league
 - Create 2 game cards that will be given to the league representatives at the pre-game meeting
- **RCCFO Officials – Officials Responsibilities**
 - Respond to head referee that you received and understand directions, and are set for the game
 - Arrive 30 minutes prior to first game start ready to take the field
 - If it takes you 15 minutes to get ready, adjust your arrival time accordingly
 - Meet with site representatives before taking the field
- **RCCFO Officials – Game Day Responsibilities**
 - Meet with site representatives (both organizations) before taking the field
 - Review and understand special rules that are in effect for the day
 - Get coaches information, list of coaches for each division
 - Provide each representative a game card containing officials for the day
 - Start game on time
 - WE DO NOT want to be the reason games are starting late, arrive on-time!
 - Game & sideline management – no tolerance and enforce
 - We are there for the kids
 - Safety of the kids is #1
 - **DO NOT RUSH** or chase cheerleaders off the field doing pregame cheer

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- Be respectful of their cheer and do coin toss AFTER they have left field
- **Officials Payment**
 - Should be prior to the start of first game, but no later than halftime of first game
 - Notify the assignors and the RCCFO president if payment is later than half time of the first game
 - If there is an incident before payment is received
 - Leave the field (safety first)
 - Report the occurrence to the assignors and the RCCFO President
 - Site / team will not receive officials until payment is received
 - RCCFO and League to work out payment before Friday
 - If not paid by Friday – officials are removed from their next week’s games and the organization will forfeit all games that week
